- Provide instruction to multi-age classrooms (e.g. grades 1-3, 4-6, 7-8)
- Support school faculty in Montessori Pedagogy
- Organize and create a visually attractive art environment
- Manage art budget for supplies and art materials
- Manage a kiln and ceramics in the classroom
- Support staff in play productions/project work as needed
